

History is learning about things that have happened in the past.







Facts I know

Facts I will learn

- In **the past**, people used **transport** pulled by horses to **travel** from one place to another.
- The first bus was invented in the Victorian times, they were pulled along by horses.
- Modern cars and most other transport is powered by **an engine**.
- During the Victorian times, there were steam trains powered by coal, but modern trains are powered by electricity.
- **Fuel** from cars **pollutes** the environment, but modern, electric cars are much better.
- Bicycles are good for the environment because they do not burn fuel.
