







RE Knowledge organiser: Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

Imam	The leader of a Mosque.	subha	Prayer beads	minaret	A tower connected to a Mosque, used for the call to prayer.	empathy	Showing an understanding of how others feel.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Muslims are followers of Islam and their God is called Allah. • The Prophet Muhammed was a teacher who shared Allah's important messages and stories with Muslims. • When Muslims talk about the Prophet Muhammed, they also say 'peace be upon him' to show he was very special. • Muslims do not draw pictures of Allah or the Prophet Muhammed, but they use calligraphy instead. • A Muslim holy place of worship is called a Mosque. • A Mosque has a minaret, dome, prayer hall, prayer mats, washroom. • The Qur'an has stories and teachings in it that Muslims use as a guide to live their lives. • Muslims need a prayer mat, water and a Qur'an to pray. • Subha (prayer beads) have 99 beads on them to represent the 99 names of Allah • Muslims pray five times a day. <p>Taught as a stand-alone unit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ramadan is when Muslims fast for a whole month – it helps them put themselves in the shoes of people who have less than them. • Eid-ul-fitr is the festival of breaking the fast at the very end of Ramadan – on this day there is no fasting. 	<div style="display: flex; flex-wrap: wrap;"> <div style="width: 50%;">  <p>star and crescent symbol of Islam</p> </div> <div style="width: 50%;">  <p>Mosque</p> </div> <div style="width: 50%;">  <p>subha (prayer beads)</p> </div> <div style="width: 50%;">  <p>prayer mat</p> </div> <div style="width: 50%;">  <p>Allah in Arabic</p> </div> <div style="width: 50%;">  <p>the Holy Qur'an</p> </div> </div>
