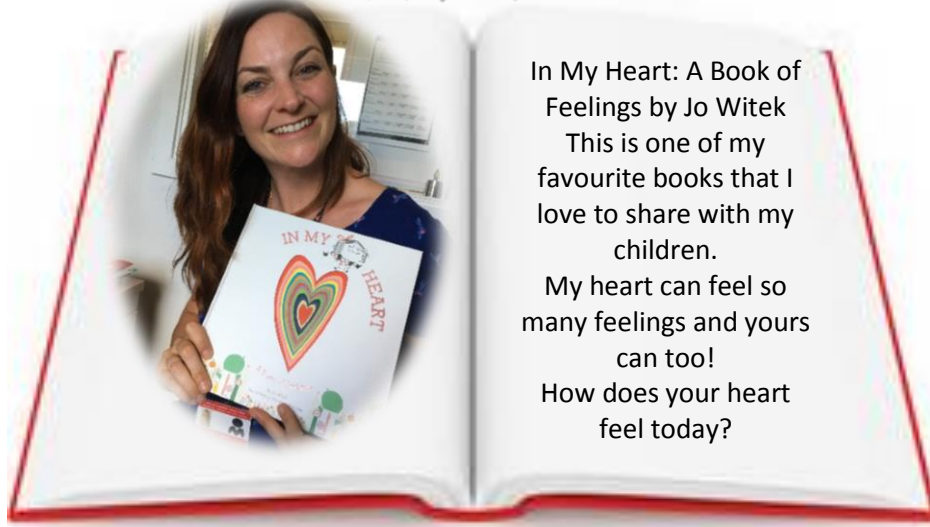

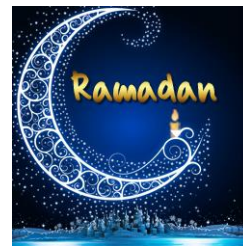
## The Life Cycle of a Butterfly by The Nursery

We are coming up to the time of Ramadan – a period of religious observance when those of the Muslim faith fast from dawn to dusk.

We recognise that some of our older children may be involved so we would appreciate it if you would let us know by completing the slip attached to the letter sent out last week.

We do not anticipate that anyone younger than Years 5 & 6 will be involved.

This is a particularly active part of the school year and as the fasting day is especially long the school recommend that children fast at the weekends only.
