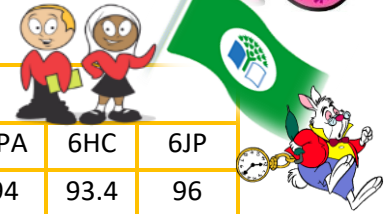

## This Week's News

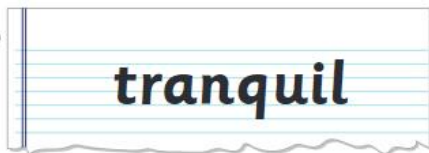

From Mr Kerr – Wonder by R. J. Palacio



*Wonder* is a hard-hitting story about a young boy named August Pullman. August, or Auggie, as he is known to his friends and family, was born with Treacher Collins syndrome, a genetic condition which affects the development of facial bones and tissue. The story charts Auggie's enrolment in a new school (he'd never been to school before) and follows his journey throughout his first year as a pupil. There are some really sad low points for Auggie but he also enjoys some thrilling moments and makes some great new friends along the way.
