Half-term closure for Key Workers' Pupils

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to you to share that, in light of the current situation with a possible plan for school to reopen to more pupils on Monday 1st June, we have made the decision to close our childcare provision for what would be the half term holiday, week commencing Monday 25th May.

We have made this decision due to the amount of work and planning that now needs to take place in order for us to be ready to reopen in June. We continue to receive information regarding government guidance, and this will continue to come through up until the 1st June. We recognise that we will need time to make amendments to our plan, alongside deep cleaning all areas of the school once more, including the classrooms where our current emergency provision is set up. We will need to update our staff teams around our plans and changes through the week and we hope you understand that with everything currently taking place, we also want to give our staff some much needed time given how hard they have been working in very difficult circumstances.

We apologise for any inconvenience this causes you but we wanted to give you as much notice as possible so you can make alternative arrangements.

Our key worker provision will reopen on Monday 1st June, irrespective of the conditional reopening of school to more pupils which may or may not happen. If school does open to more children, this will mean that we will need to make some changes to how our current provision works. We will send out further detail of changes to how we are currently running our keyworker provision as we have more information to share. We know that some of you will have children in a year group where we expect to reopen, and again, we will be in touch with you in due course to explain how they will be supported in school.
