

In **literacy** we will be focusing on the books 'Dinosaur Roar!' by Paul and Henrietta Stickland and 'And the Train Goes...' by William Bee.

We will be practising our fine motor skills and writing our name.

How can I help at home?

Listen to the stories on YouTube.

Do your homework every week!

Talk about journeys your family have been on... in the car?

On the bus? On the train?

In **maths** we will be focusing on matching numeral and quantity to 5, counting to 10, using our fingers to show the correct number, positional language, 2D shapes and patterns (ABAB)

How can I help at home?

Sing lots of number songs e.g., 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish allowed, one elephant went out to play etc.

Go on a shape hunt: what shapes can you find in your home?

Make a pattern using items in your home e.g., apple, pear, apple, pear.

In **phonics** we will be focusing on Phase 1 letters and sounds.

How can I help at home?

Play lots of different listening games such as 'I spy' or 'Simon Says' etc.

Go on a sound walk. This could be in your home, in the garden, when you go shopping etc.



It is vital that your child gets to school on-time every day. The doors are open from **8.40am** so you can bring your child in to settle for the school day. The bell goes at 9am. Nursery finishes at **3.05pm**.

Classes are rewarded with £5 vouchers for the best attendance.
