

This half term we will be learning about superheroes. We will be setting up a superhero centre in our classroom where the children will be dressing up as superheroes, rescuing others and saving the day!

We will be talking about the superheroes that we are familiar with and what qualities you need to be a superhero.

As part of our topic we will also be looking at and talking about real heroes, these might be people that we have heard about or even people who live with us.

English

We will be reading lots of stories about Superheroes. We will be encouraging children to talk about what they can see in the pictures and to predict what might happen at the end of the story, answering questions using full sentences. The children will also be developing an understanding of action words (who is jumping, running, flying, climbing...)

At home

Read comics together and talk about the superheroes in them.

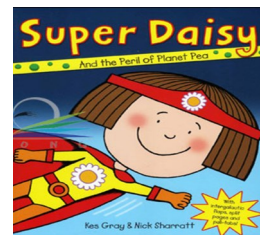
Role play going on a superhero adventure or rescuing somebody to help develop your child's language and imagination.
