Well done to all the families that completed the February Half Term Shape Challenge. You found some great long, curved, round, straight objects.



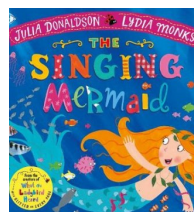
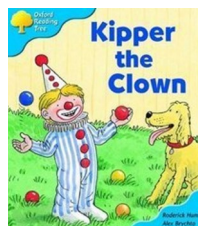
