We will be reading lots of books about being under the sea, including Commotion in the Ocean, Pirates love Underpants, Smiley Shark, Fidgety Fish and the Storm Whale. We will also be looking at non-fiction books to find out lots of amazing facts. We will be working hard to learn the different features of a book. We will be looking closely at rhyming words, and completing a rhyming string.



We will continue our work on 2D Shape, naming and describing properties of shapes.

We have been doing a great job learning all about numbers and counting, we will continue to develop these number skills and will begin to look at finding one more than or one less than a given number.

As part of our Pirate learning we will also be using maps, positional and directional language to search for treasure.



We love to get messy and creative in Nursery. This half term we will be encouraging children to create their own treasure maps, telescopes, treasure chests, and treasure. We will use the sand area to dig for treasure and the water area to investigate sinking and floating.
