How can I help at home?

Do your homework every week!

Talk about different roles and jobs. Talk about who helps us in school and at home, who keeps us safe and healthy.

In **maths** we will be focusing on patterns, height, length, mass, and capacity.

How can I help at home?

Do your homework every week!

Create your own ABAB/ AAB/ ABB patterns at home e.g., xoxo/xxo/xoo.

Find out who is the tallest and shortest in your house.

Read stories such as the 3 Little Pigs.

In **phonics** we will be focusing on oral blending and segmenting. We will be learning these sounds: s a t p i n m d g o c k e u r h b f l j

How can I help at home?

Hear, say and write initial sounds in words.

Play lots of different listening games such as 'I spy' or 'Simon Says' etc.

Play lots of blending and segmenting games (*there will be lots of ideas and games in your homework each week*).
