

In **literacy** we will be focusing on the books 'Emergency!' By Margaret Mayo & Alex Ayliffe and 'A Superhero Like You' By Ranj Singh.

We will be practising our fine and gross motor skills and writing our name.

How can I help at home?

Listen to the stories on YouTube.

Do your homework every week!

Talk about different roles and jobs. Talk about who helps us in school and at home. Who keeps us safe and healthy.

In **maths** we will be focusing on matching numbers 4,5, one more/ less, counting to 10, positional language and subitising to 3.

How can I help at home?

Sing lots of number songs e.g., 1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive, one elephant went out to play etc.

Practise putting your favourite toy in different positions... e.g. **on** the table, **under** the table, **next to** the table, **above** the table.

In **phonics** we will be focusing on Phase 1 letters and sounds.

How can I help at home?

Hear, say and write initial sounds in words.

Play lots of different listening games such as 'I spy' or 'Simon Says' etc.

Go on a sound walk. This could be in your home, in the garden, when you go shopping etc.



It is vital that your child gets to school on-time every day. The doors are open from **8.40am** so you can bring your child in to settle for the school day. The bell goes at 9am. Nursery finishes at **3.05pm**.
