Closure of Year 5 Bubble

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are writing to inform you that a pupil within the Year 5 bubble has tested positive for Coronavirus. The initial source of the virus was **not** in school.

To keep everyone in school as safe as possible, we have shut the Year 5 bubble for 14 days from the last contact with the child. All Year 5 pupils must now isolate at home. The provisional return date for staff and pupils from the Year 5 bubble is Tuesday 22nd September 2020.

The rest of the school remains **OPEN** and siblings of Year 5 children should continue to come to school as usual, as advised by Public Health England. If children from any year groups develop symptoms of a persistent cough, high temperature or change to sense of taste/smell then they should not come to school and isolate/book a test.

You do not need to book a test or isolate if your child does not show symptoms. If any child or any person in your household develops symptoms (high temperature, or a new and continuous cough, or loss of smell and taste) please book a test. The whole household should isolate until you have received the result. If it is positive, you will all need to isolate.

Please be assured that the school is continuing with protective measures and cleaning and hygiene arrangements are in place throughout the day. If you have any concerns, please contact us directly and we will do our very best to help you.
