English

This half-term the children will be writing diary entries based on Howard Carter's discovery of Tutankhamun's tomb. The children will also be writing a non-fiction explanation text on the process of mummification linking to our Big Question topic. During guided reading, the children will focus on finding inference in a text they read and explaining their reasoning using examples from the text.

SPAG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar)

The children will be continuing to learn upper Key Stage 2 writing features, including parenthesis (brackets, dashes and commas) and use of a relative clause. They will also be focusing on using spelling words with different prefix or suffix.

Mathematics

This half-term, the children will be continuing to learn about the formal method of multiplication. They will be multiplying up to 4-digits by 2-digits. The children will also be learning to use the bus stop method for division.

It is essential that children practice their time tables weekly using TT Rockstars or Hit the Button. Each child has their own individual login for TT Rockstars. If your child needs a reminder of their login, please contact their class teacher.

French & Music

Children will be having weekly steel pan sessions (with Mr Sinckler) and singing lessons with Ed Robinson on Friday. French lessons (with Madame Norris) are on Thursday mornings.

Computing

This half-term, the children will be focusing on Binary Code Programming with Mr Quilliams.
