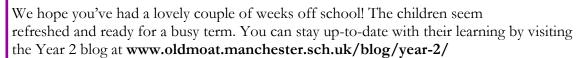

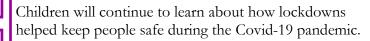
Children will write their own version of "The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark" and also produce an information text about owls.
